WELCOME PARENTS!

Our camp is designed to provide a fun, safe, and exciting experience where kids can learn, play, and make lifelong memories. CAMP BASICS:

- Camp Dates: May 19th – August 1st (Closed May 26th and July 4th)
- Hours: 7:00 am – 5:30 pm
- Location: First Baptist Church – 118 W South Street, Mayfield, KY 42066

WHAT YOUR CAMPER NEEDS:

- Play-friendly clothes and comfy shoes (no flip-flops!)
- Water bottle (Please label with your child's name)
- Packed lunch/snacks (If needed)
- Towel and swimsuit (bring daily except Thursdays unless otherwise noted)
- Backpack for personal belongings

LEAVE THESE AT HOME:

- Electronics (phones, tablets, gaming devices)
- Toys, trading cards, or personal items
- Flip flops (only sandals with straps are allowed)
- Money (unless stated otherwise for specific field trips)

DROP OFF AND PICK UP RULES:

- Drop-Off and Pick-Up Rules
- Parent/Guardians must sign children in and out each day
- Only authorized adults may pick up your child (ID required!)
- If you are late picking your child up, a \$5 per minute late fee will apply

HEALTH AND SAFETY:

- YMCA Camp Staff cannot administer medication, except EpiPens and inhalers in emergencies
- A child should stay at home if they have a fever (100.3+), contagious illness, or lice. If one of these incidents happens while the child is at camp, the parent must arrange for the child to be picked up immediately
- In a medical emergency, we'll call parents/guardians or emergency services if needed
- If a child obtains 3 discipline forms, they will be expelled from the program. The YMCA has the right to expel a child at any time, for any reason that seems fitting. Physical altercations are grounds for immediate expulsion

CAMP RULES AND RESPECT:

- Campers are expected to be kind, respectful, and follow instructions
- The YMCA core values (Caring, Honesty, Respect, Responsibility, and Faith) are the heart of camp life
- Zero tolerance for bullying. Suspension or expulsion may apply

FIELD TRIPS OR SPECIAL EVENTS:

- All field trips require a signed permission slip. These will be provided each Thursday to be filled out during drop-off
- Transportation is provided by a Graves County School Bus and CDL-licensed driver
- If extra supplies are needed for a trip, you will be notified the day before



PAYMENT & REGISTRATION POLICIES:

Weekly Rates ➡ Member:

- Part Time (1-3 days): \$75
- Full Time (4-5 days): \$100

Weekly Rates ➡ Nonmember:

- Part Time (1-3 days): \$150
- Full Time (4-5 days): \$200

- Notify the Camp Director at least a week in advance if your child won't attend to avoid charges
- If your payments fall 2 weeks behind, attendance will be paused until payment is made
- If you need Financial Assistance, please reach out to the Camp Director for more information
